Incredibly Smooth

An important part of Peugeot 504's comfort secret is its unique, four wheel independent suspension and specially designed shock absorbers that soak up the bumps on any surface even when the car is fully loaded. To make sure Peugeot 504 runs quietly, its engine, transmission and rear axle are separated from the body by special rubber mountings to keep road noise where it belongs - outside the cabin. A generous application of sound insulation throughout the body further hushes down engine noise.




Peugeot safety through and through and all around you

Peugeot 504 has a strong unit body that is engineered to protect passengers in a crash. Both front and rear ends are designed to collapse gradually on impact, absorbing energy that would otherwise be transferred to the occupants of the car.

The passenger compartment, on the other hand, is designed to provide all round protection. Reinforced substructure and a network of side and cross members form a rigid cage to protect the occupants.





CENTRE RIGHT Dual virgut, power assisted disc brakes on all four wheels. BOTTOM RIGHT Centrally located handbrake and console.










The Peugeot Estates Our 504 plus a whole lot more.

For a start the Estate series is a whole foot longer. With a 15cm (6") longer wheelbase. And instead of following the sedan roof, we've lifted the line to make loading easy. Reversing in to load is no risk either with an all-rubber back bumper and hefty rubber buffers to protect the tail-light assemblies.


Underneath, the changes are no less dramatic. Heavier 185 x 355 steel belted radials are fitted. While in place of the sedan's independent suspension, a heavy-duty solid rear axle. And in place of two coil springs, four coil springs. The result is an estate series built to hold up under loads that cause most other

wagons to drag their tails. The result? — all the good manners and renowned roadability of the 504 sedan.

Inside are more Peugeot advantages. With the rear seat folded, carrying space totals a mammoth 1.80m³ (over 64 cu. ft.). In the Superluxe Estate there's seating for five adults in two rows and room for a mountain of luggage. From the rear, the one-piece door swings up easily on hydraulic struts, revealing a clear loading deck. The Superluxe Estate deck is of mahogany laminate equipped with rubber runners. While the seven-passenger Family Estate has a third 'forward-facing' row of seats, it still offers around 12 cu. ft. for luggage.

The 504 power plant is a front mounted, highly efficient in-line four cylinder engine of 1971 cc. The aluminium alloy cylinder head features offset hemispherical combustion chambers. The cast iron cylinder block is equipped with removable wet type liners. The entire engine is tilted at a 45° angle to the right. This allows for a low line in the bonnet for better visibility, facilitates accessibility to external engine components and lowers the centre of gravity. The result? — a better handling car.

In these times of increasing energy costs and decreasing reserves the 504 engine is a marvel. Compact it may be, but it's all heart and the more you ask of it the more it gives. Very satisfying.
