



As such, Peugeot have been able to utilise the most modern manufacturing plant and equipment available. The manufacturing facility at Mulhouse, for example, includes a vast investment in computer-controlled machine tools and automatic assembly

As the major manufacturer in Europe, we can offer a breathtaking choice of fine cars. Each with its own personality, each with the unmistakable Peugeot pedigree,

which means quality and reliability built into each car produced.

Safety is also another hallmark of Peugeot design. Peugeot's contribution to research and application of safety techniques and design has become a major factor in the overall development of vehicle safety throughout the world. New models are designed to incorporate active and passive features derived from Peugeot's on-going test programme in which many vehicles are destroyed in accident simulations. Peugeot's own unique Safety Synthesis Vehicle highlights the importance which Peugeot place upon vehicle safety and each production car is illustrative of the ability to take increasingly demanding theoretical requirements and to transform these into practical design solutions.

Engineering strength and a sound basis for reliability is laid by thorough research,

planning and design. Only the finest quality materials and components are used. A car is only as good as the parts which go to make it, and by manufacturing a higher proportion of parts than virtually any other car manufacturer, Peugeot ensure that both the components and the finished product meet an extremely high standard. Major mechanical components, body shells and even sheet metal are manufactured in Peugeot factories. Peugeot also manufacture their own unique shock absorbers, to a patented design.

To match this, anti-corrosion treatment is thorough. Body panels have their edges coated with zinc primer before assembly and the finished shell is given phosphating treatment in key areas. Vulnerable body areas are zinc plated or made

from galvanised steel.

Underbody joints and box sections are also treated with zinc-based primer. The entire body shell then undergoes an electrolytic treatment which coats it with synthetic resin primer.

A PVC anti-chip compound is sprayed under wheel arches, door sills and front and rear panels. And finally, after painting, main box sections are injected with a heavy wax mixture, and the entire underbody is sprayed with a wax/tar compound.

Added to this is the constant pre-production testing of parts and prototype models. Each and every prototype component is tested for performance on special computer-controlled machines at the Company's Research Centres at Paris and Belchamp. Prototypes and models currently in production are subjected to a

Belchamp. Prototypes and models currently in production are subjected to a complete and continuing test programme during which many millions of miles will be covered on the giant test-track at Belchamp.

Quality control of production models is continuous and thorough. Every engine is run on a test-bed, and every gearbox tested before being installed in the car.

Once assembled, every vehicle is then tested on a rolling road.

At this stage, most manufacturers complete their testing, but Peugeot go further. Each car is taken from the rolling road and driven over a test-track which includes tight bends, humps, cobblestones and wet and dry braking tunnels.

One in eight of the factory staff is engaged exclusively in quality control, and so thorough are the inspection procedures that Car Magazine reported, "Regardless of the make and price of the final product, we have yet to see more thoroughly inspected production line cars."

The result of this diligence is a better-built, more reliable car. When you do need a service, only once every 10,000 miles on petrol models with oil change and safety check at 5,000 miles, you have a nationwide network of approved Peugeot Dealers, with Peugeot-trained personnel, throughout the length and breadth of Britain, so help is never far away. 
